Early life. Lewis's father worked at the Liverpool Docks and his mother was a local council worker; there were no musicians in his family background. Lewis began by playing the cello, the only instrument for which his school could offer him tuition. At the age of 14 he was accepted by Chetham's School of Music in Manchester, where his piano studies blossomed.
